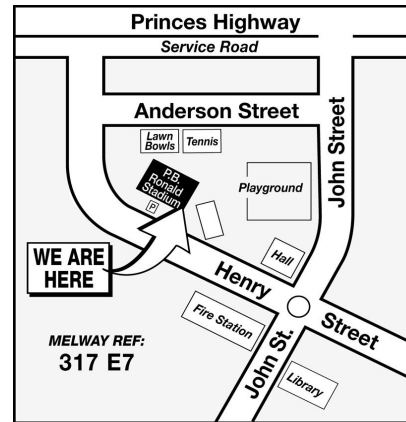

Certificates in General Education for Adults

Join our small classes which focus on individual needs.

Improve your reading, writing, maths, spelling and computer abilities.
Improve job options, prepare for entrance exams, or further study

Specialist activities are offered as part of Certificates in General Education.

Students learn through a variety of activities including , life and job skills, food hygiene and first aid training.

Lower level certificates cater for non-English speakers and those with lower levels of Literacy with oral conversation, basic reading, writing and practical maths.

Advanced certificates offer more complex tasks including a special advanced maths, advanced English and computer classes.

The four Certificates in General Education for Adults are flexible. Students may start at any time that there is a place available. As the course is self paced and competency based there are no exams only records of progress.

There are no pre requisites for these courses.

All assessment will be based on the principles of competency-based training and assessment. In general, a holistic approach will be taken to assessment, using integrated tasks which cover the unit requirements.

Upon successful completion an Accredited Certificate will be issued. Students may also receive a Statement of Attainment for completed units.

Concessions do not apply if the student's tuition contribution is being met by a Commonwealth Government agency or as part of a Commonwealth program or initiative or other Government schemes.

ACFE funded courses incur a minimum charge of \$55. The maximum any student can pay in course fees for ACFE funded

courses in one year is \$877.00. Concession card holders are required to only pay the minimum course fee once during a calendar year and are entitled to unlimited ACFE funded courses. Student registration , amenities and material fee and text book will still apply to some courses.
